Certificate at Level 3:	A minimum IELTS (Academic) score of 5.0 with no band score lower than 5.0
Certificate at Level 4:	A minimum IELTS (Academic) score of 5.5 with no band score lower than 5.0
Certificate or Diploma at Level 5:	A minimum IELTS (Academic) score of 5.5 with no band score lower than 5.0
Certificate or Diploma at level 6 or 7:	A minimum IELTS (Academic) score of 6.0 with no band score lower than 5.5
Degree:	A minimum IELTS (Academic) score of 6.0 with no band score lower than 5.5
Bachelor of Engineering Technology	A minimum IELTS (Academic) score of 6.0 with writing and speaking score no less than 6.0; reading and listening bands no less than 5.5
Graduate Certificate or Graduate Diploma at Level 7:	A minimum IELTS (Academic) score of 6 with no band score lower than 5.5
Graduate Dip Engineering Technology	A minimum IELTS (Academic) score of 6.5 with no band score lower than 6.0
Postgraduate Certificate/Diploma Level 7 or Master's Degree at Level 9	A minimum IELTS (Academic) score of 6.5 with no band score lower than 6.0
Master of Professional Practice	A minimum IELTS (Academic) score of 7.0 with no band score lower than 6.5
