A minimum IELTS (Academic) score of 5.5 with no band score lower than 5.0

Certificate or Diploma at level 6 or 7:

A minimum IELTS (Academic) score of 6.0 with no band score lower than 5.5

Degree:

A minimum IELTS (Academic) score of 6.0 with no band score lower than 5.5

*A minimum IELTS (Academic) score of 6.0 with writing and speaking score no less than 6.0; reading and listening bands no less than 5.5*

Graduate Certificate or Graduate Diploma at Level 7:

A minimum IELTS (Academic) score of 6 with no band score lower than 5.5

*A minimum IELTS (Academic) score of 6.5 with no band score lower than 6.0*

Postgraduate Certificate/Diploma Level 8 or Master's Degree at Level 9

A minimum IELTS (Academic) score of 6.5 with no band score lower than 6.0
