Strands

Health assistance

Develop the skills and knowledge required to provide person-centred health care under the direction and delegation of a health professional. Work in environments such as hospitals and rest homes.

Support worker

Develop the skills and knowledge required to provide person-centred support to those who need assistance in independent day-to-day living.

- Demonstrate and apply knowledge of professional and ethical behaviour
- Understand and describe a person's holistic health
- Learn important communication skills
- Learn how to respond to and recognise change

Programme structure

You'll typically spend one day a week in the classroom. Plus you'll put your skills into practice with 220 hours of supervised work experience; we'll help you find a placement. The programme is flexible to help you fit the course around family and work commitments.

NCEA level 1 or equivalent qualification/work experience AND evidence of suitability based on an interview, health declaration, safety check under the Vulnerable Children's Act 2014 and referee reports.

Work experience agencies may require health checks before accepting the student on a work placement. These requirements are discussed with all potential students at their interview before acceptance onto the programme.
